BMT Aerospace builds new facility in Iasi



BMT Aerospace is currently building a new facility for its manufacturing plant in Iaşi. Total investments are estimated at 23M euro and the plant will have a total surface of 11.000 m². Currently, the location in Iaşi is producing only machining spur gears and splined shafts. With the new developments, the company will be able to produce at the highest quality also bevel gears and grind all splines and will start the Low Pressure Carburizing process in the Heat Treatment area.

All investments will make possible a fully vertical and flexible process integration, unique for gear manufacturers in aerospace business, that will bring BMT Aerospace Romania in a very competitive market position, as being among the few companies that have all these capabilities under same facility.

This investment will also have an impact on local community because many new highly specialized jobs will be created and cooperation with Universities and research centers will increase significantly. BMT believes in developing a long term partnership in Romania and will continue to invest in talented workforce and state-of-the-art automated manufacturing capabilities.

Sonaca inaugurates factory near Cluj-Napoca



Sonaca Group has inaugurated on the 10th of March a factory in Moldovenești, Cluj county, where it produces wing components for the Airbus A320 aircraft. The investment of up to €12 million has been carried out by the firm Sonaca Aerospace Transilvania. The construction of the plant took 18 months and the first production lines became operational in mid-September 2016.

The Minister for Business Environment Alexandru Petrescu, the State Secretary for Foreign investments Harry Illan Laufer, the Director of Operations of Sonaca Jan Broeckx, the General manager of Sonaca Transilvania Laurent Maroy, the Mayor of Moldovenești Ioan Mărginean and Ambassador Thomas Baekelandt cut the traditional ribbon at the opening ceremony.

Sonaca Group is a global Belgian company active in the development, manufacturing, and assembly of advanced structures for civil, military, and space markets. The group is especially known for its wing movables expertise where it is regarded as the world leader serving most of the primes . It has production facilities in China, Europe, North-America, and South-America and employs over 2500 people including 350 engineers.
